## ANNUAL SCHOOL REPORT 2023-24

Father's Day was celebrated on 19<sup>th</sup> June by presenting a Malayalam skit by the Class 11 students under the guidance of the Malayalam Department Teachers. The Investiture Ceremony was conducted on 23<sup>rd</sup> June. Yoga day was celebrated by organizing a beautiful Yoga display. Various informative classes were conducted on topics like recharging of wells, waste management by the Kelachandra group and anti-narcotics by the Excise Department.

A Planetarium was set up in the campus on 30<sup>th</sup> June. Bright stars Eve and Graduation Ceremony was conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> July to honor all the achievers of Class 10 and 12. This year also Clemis School is proud to announce 100% result in the CBSE Board Examination 2022-23 of Class 10 and 12. Eliza P Mathew of Science Batch and Sivananda N.V. of Commerce Batch of Class 12 were the toppers with 95% each. 10 students of Class 12 scored above 90%. Jeevan S. Varghese was the topper in Class 10 with 97%. 17 students of Class 10 scored above 90%.

PTA and Open-house meetings were arranged. Talents' fest was on  $4^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  August, a platform for students to showcase their talents. Onam was celebrated on  $25^{th}$  August. Teacher's Day was organised on  $5^{th}$  September. All activities of the day was conducted by the Clemis School Teachers.

A District Level Karate Championship was hosted by Clemis School under the leadership of Mr. Binu Andrews, our Karate Master. We celebrated the Grandparent's Day on 11<sup>th</sup> September, initiated and led by the Teachers of Knanaya Nursery School. Educational Tour was organized for Class 5 to 12 on 11<sup>th</sup> October at Wonderla, Kochi. More than 400 students participated in the tour. Kids' fest was on 11<sup>th</sup> October.

Periodic tests, class tests, term examinations were conducted on regular intervals.
