

PROSPECTUS

General Guidelines:

1. Students will have to wear uniforms on all working days.
2. Uniform clothes and text books will be supplied from the school on prescribed dates.
3. As the mark lists will have to be submitted to the school at the time of admission, students are advised to have in their possession sufficient number of copies of certified extracts of the marks in the qualifying examination and the pages containing the date of birth, before admission. Their qualifying certificates will be returned to them only after the completion of the course.
4. An identity card will be issued to every student after admission. This card has to be brought to the school everyday.
5. Guardians and students are expected to co-operate in the development programme of the school so that the school may fulfill its obligations to the society effectively.
6. Various scholarships and endowments are available in the school. They will be disbursed among the deserving students.
7. School buses will be operated to different places. Students who want to avail travel facilities in school buses are directed to contact the office.
8. All the parents are members of the PTA. Parents are requested to meet the Class Teachers and Principal occasionally.
9. Candidates seeking admission shall give an undertaking, that they will not indulge in any type of ragging inside and outside the campus.
10. Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the campus.

 1. Birth Certificate and Aadhar
 2. Mark List of Class 10
 3. Transfer Certificate (original)
 4. Conduct Certificate (original)
 Final selection will be made only after the interview.
